Email marketing/campaign

You want to beware of any web-based tool that is free. They could use you to harvest email addresses that they resell for spamming purposes. Best to use a desktop client to send bulk email, or a paid online service. I recommend Constant Contact

Feed Readers/aggregator

Client-based software readers, like email clients (Microsoft Outlook, Apple Mail) will download RSS feeds like they do email, so you can read them offline
